This sixth meeting continues to profile the work of early researchers in philosophy of education. We aim to continue our work of developing a fertile environment for discussion, networking and mentoring across a range of interests. We strongly encourage both new and more experienced scholars to get involved in what has become an active and supportive intellectual community. The organisers of this weekend seminar invite participation from a variety of perspectives, and request submissions of works in progress on the theme of *'Research from the Margins'*.

We are inviting papers of 2000-3000 words. A limited number of slots for participants and presenters is available and slots will be allocated on a first come first served basis, but priority will be given to first-time participants. Please respond with an expression of interest, including a draft title and a 100-200 word abstract to Lindsey Farnsworth ([L.J.Farnsworth@sheffield.ac.uk](mailto:L.J.Farnsworth@sheffield.ac.uk)) using the heading NRiPoE2015 before **31 May 2015**. The deadline for submission of full papers is 16 August 2015.

The seminar will run from 1 pm Friday to 12.30 pm Sunday. There will be 3 time slots for presenters to discuss their work on Friday, Saturday morning and afternoon, with a short business meeting and optional participant-led workshops planned for Sunday morning. We will, as far as we are able, group the proposals thematically for each of the three time slots, and will distribute them by e-mail prior to the seminar so that everyone can read them beforehand. Those presenting will offer a brief trigger presentation which will be followed by open discussion.

Thanks to generous funding from the PESGB, bed and breakfast accommodation and meals will be funded for all participants. Support for travel is limited to £120. If institutional funding is available for your travel costs, please take advantage of this to enable us to support others whose costs exceed £120. The conference registration fee is £25, payable in advance with confirmation of participation by **28 June 2015**.
