ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

March 2015

Under the terms of the constitution, the President is elected for life. The Chair is elected for three years, one year in advance of taking up office, and is normally ineligible for immediate re-election. The Secretary, Treasurer, Conference Programme Chair and Conference Organiser are elected for a period of three years and are eligible for immediate re-election. Six members of the Society are elected as members of the Executive Committee for a term of three years. The retiring members are not eligible for re-election for two years. The retiring President or Chair shall be eligible for election at an Annual General Meeting to the honorary title of Vice-President.

This year elections will be held for the positions of Honorary Vice-President, Conference Organiser (2018 -) and four Elected Members.

Richard Smith served as Chair 2011 – 14 and Vice-Chair 2014 – 2016 and is therefore eligible for election as Honorary Vice-President. David Aldridge, conference organiser from 2015 – 18, has indicated his intention only to serve one term and, in order to allow a one year handover, an election for the position Conference Organiser (2018 -) will be conducted at the 2017 AGM. Four Elected Members come to the end of their terms in 2017: Ruth Wareham, Mary Richardson, David Lewin and Anders Schinkel.

Nominations are invited for the position of Conference Organiser (2018 -) and Four Elected Members.

Nominees should be proposed and seconded and should indicate their consent.

Nominations can be made by email and should be sent to the Secretary at h.b.kotzee@bham.ac.uk. Nominations can also be made by completing forms that will be available on the elections board in the Conference Office. Nominations close at 5pm on Friday 31 March 2017.
